## **Police Seek Vehicle, Driver that Caused Motorcycle Crash**

SUFFOLK, VA (October 13, 2010)) Suffolk Police are asking for assistance from the public in locating the vehicle and driver that caused a motorcycle crash in which one person was injured. According to the police report, yesterday at 11:10 a.m., a motorcycle was traveling on Bennett's Pasture Rd. when a silver Mercedes failed to stop at a stop sign at Lee Farm Lane. The Mercedes proceeded onto Bennett's Pasture Rd., into the path of the motorcycle.

The operator of the motorcycle was forced to lay the motorcycle down. He was injured and transported to Sentara Norfolk Hospital where he was treated and released. The accident was captured on the video equipment of a nearby business.

Police are asking that anyone who might be able to identify the suspect vehicle, which they believe to be a 2000 or 2001 Mercedes with tinted windows, to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
