UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (July 21, 2010) Just before midnight last night, a Virginia Beach man turned himself in to Suffolk Police after photos showing a suspect committing larcenies from area ABC stores showed on area news broadcasts. Kaleel Akeem Baron, age 25, of the 5600 blk. of Dodington Court responded to a downtown police precinct and advised officers that he was the man they were looking for from the news. Baron was interviewed and charged with one count of petit larceny in Suffolk.

The suspect's information will be shared with the jurisdictions where the other larcenies occurred. Baron is being held at Western Tidewater Regional Jail on \$1,000 bond.

POLICE SEEK TO IDENTIFY LARCENY SUSPECT

SUFFOLK, VA (July 20, 2010) Suffolk Police are asking for assistance in identifying a subject who has an affinity for top-shelf liquor, especially when he doesn't pay for it. Police advise on July 17, 2010, just after 2 p.m., a black male entered the ABC store located in the 6500 blk. of Hampton Roads Blvd. The subject is observed on surveillance video removing a bottle of Ciroc Vodka, valued at \$68, from a top shelf. The subject placed the 1.75 liter bottle in his pants and walked out of the store.

The suspect is described as 5'7"-5'10", 175-185 lbs., with black hair worn in dreadlocks.

While police were taking a report on the larceny in Suffolk, the same subject stole Vodka from a Churchland ABC Store. The same subject is a suspect in the larceny of Grey Goose Vodka from an ABC store on Sam's Club Way in Chesapeake on July 11, 2010.

If anyone is able to identify this subject, they are asked to call Crime Line. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
