**Police Seek to Identify Suspects in Credit Card Fraud**

SUFFOLK, VA (March 25, 2011) Suffolk Police are investigating a credit card fraud and are requesting assistance from the public in identifying the suspects. Police advise that the victim of the fraud resides in New York. On March 9 at approximately 9:14 p.m., the victim's charge card number was used at Wilco located in the 1500 block of Holland Road in Suffolk.

The subject that used the card number purchased three cartons of Newport cigarettes. The account number was used approximately an hour later at a BP in Franklin.

Images of the suspects in this case were captured on surveillance video. Both were black, males, 5'6"-5'7". They were reported to have Jamaican accents. The subjects were operating a light colored, crossover type vehicle.

Anyone that may be able to identify the suspects is asked to call Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.

Detective Q. Beers is the lead investigator assigned to the case.
