Suffolk Traffic Safety Checkpoint Nets Arrests and Summonses

SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA (November 15, 2010) Suffolk Police arrested five people and issued dozens of summonses following a traffic safety checkpoint operation. The checkpoint was set-up in the 1800 block of North Main Street in both directions on late Friday night, November 12th.

More than 800 vehicles passed through the checkpoint by the time the operation ended early Saturday morning. Through their investigation, officers arrested two people for Driving under the influence. One person was arrested for driving while under the influence of drugs. Two more people were taken into custody on outstanding warrants.

Officers wrote 45 summonses ranging from driving with a suspended license to driving with defective vehicle equipment.
