SUFFOLK, VIRGINIA (October 18, 2010) Two men have been charged with breaking into houses at night while the owners were home. Suffolk Police advise Christopher R. Richardson, age 20, of the 600 blk. of W. Constance Rd., and Caleb Bateman, age 19, of the 2600 blk. of Buckingham Rd., were charged this weekend with two counts of burglary and two counts of grand larceny for breaking into residences in the Riverview section of the city during the first week of June 2010.

Items stolen during the break-ins included cell phones, computers, a camera, alcohol, cigars, charge cards and cash. The break-ins occurred in the 700 blk. of N. Broad St and 600 blk. of Dumville Ave.

Detectives are investigating whether these subjects are also connected to a burglary in the same neighborhood in September. Detectives J. Williams and Detective J. Protzeller are the investigators assigned to the cases.
