Teen Charged with Attempted Arson and Threat to Burn at High School

SUFFOLK, VA (May 21, 2010) – Investigators from the Suffolk Fire Marshal's Office have charged a sixteen-year-old Nansemond River High student with threatening to burn and attempted arson. Members of the Fire Marshal's office responded to Nansemond River High School on Tuesday, May 11, 2010, in reference to a female student that had a lighter, had made threats and had attempted to set a fire in the school in an upstairs bathroom.

An investigation was conducted and petitions were secured for threatening to burn and attempted arson. The juvenile was arrested on Thursday, May 20, 2010. She is currently being held at Tidewater Detention Home.
