Police Seek to Identify Suspect Passing Counterfeit Checks

SUFFOLK, VA (June 29, 2010) Suffolk Police are investigating a case involving counterfeit checks and are asking for assistance from the public. Investigators advise that on May 31st, a subject passed a counterfeit check in the amount of \$210.93 at the Food Lion on Town Point Road at approximately 4:30 p.m. Approximately forty minutes later, the same subject uttered a second counterfeit check at Walmart located on College Drive. That check was for in excess of \$500.00.

Police have obtained surveillance video from the locations and still photos are attached. The subject in the photo is a black male with light skin.

Anyone that might be able to identify the suspect is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give a name or appear in court. If the caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
