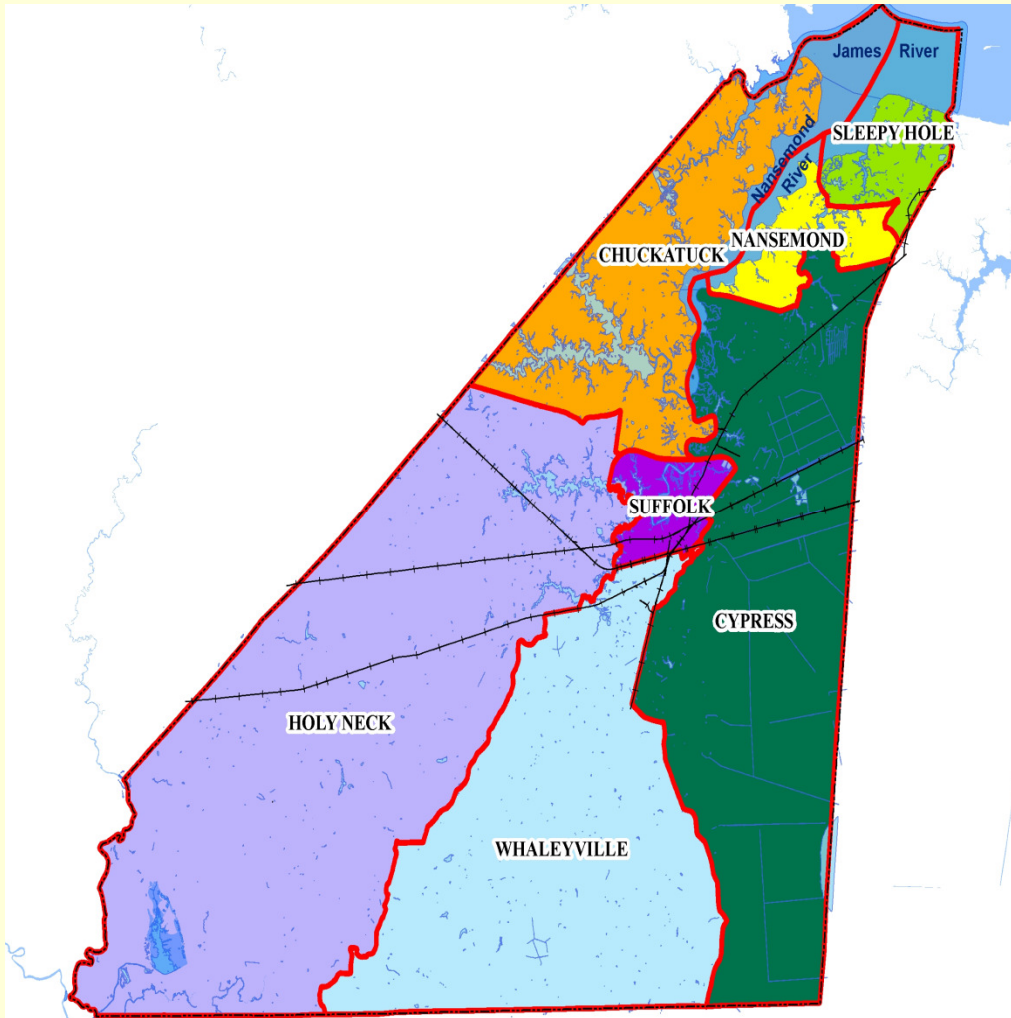

Proposed Working Map



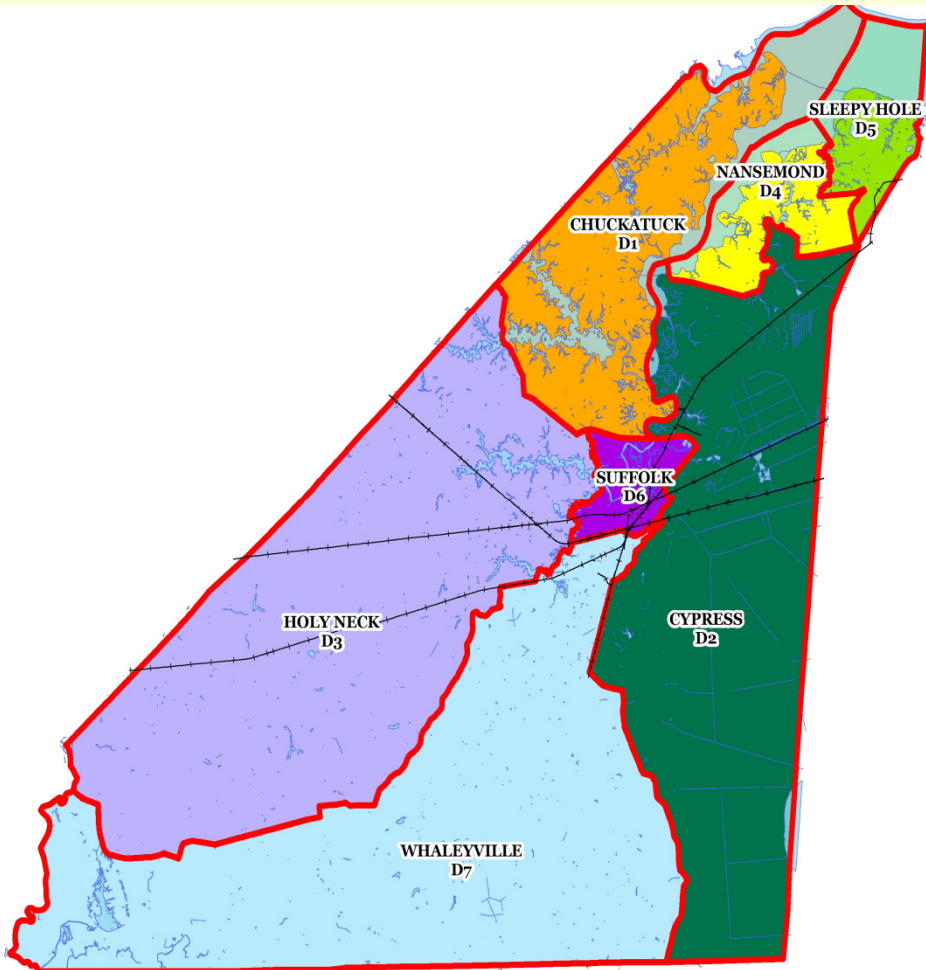
