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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 16, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, July 16, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound inside lane closure on Bridge Road at Windward Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., July 9 through July 17.

(Camp Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Camp Avenue closed at South Division Street from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., July 15 through July 19.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Godwin Boulevard between the Route 58 interchange and Kings Highway for litter control and vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will have crews in the 1800 block of Cotton Farm Lane, 1600 block of Moores Point Road and the 8300 block of Hudgins Cirlce from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

(Lewis Avenue) – A contractor will have a crew working on Lewis Avenue between Spruce Street and County Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile shoulder course in the 1000 to 1100 blocks of Portsmouth Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Pine Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a flagging operation in the 100 block of Pine Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Carolina road between the airport and North Carolina State line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(North Lloyd Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Lloyd Street closed with a detour from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have both outside lanes eastbound and westbound closed for shoulder repairs on Pruden Boulevard between Meade Parkway and Lida Avenue overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Route 58 eastbound between the Wilroy interchange and the Chesapeake City limits overnight from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

(Rosewood Drive and Jackson Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operations on Rosewood Drive and Jackson Road for drainage maintenance from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations in the 1500 block of Glenhaven Drive from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and the 100 block of Berkshire Boulevard from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. for asphalt maintenance.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Kenyon Road, Old Myrtle Road, Archers Mill Road, Freeman Mill Road, Spivey Run Road, Longstreet Lane, and Crittenden Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Woodrow Avenue and North 8th Street) – A contractor will have crews in the 100 block of Woodrow Avenue and the 100 block of North 8th Street from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Eclipse Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 9000 block of Eclipse Drive for a paving operation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 22 and July 23.

Ongoing Projects:

(Whaleyville Boulevard and Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a periodic southbound flagging operations within the 900 to 1600 blocks of Carolina Road and the 1500 to 1800 blocks of Whaleyville Boulevard for shoulder restoration and final pavement repairs from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 20 through July 31.

(Wilroy Road) – Beginning Sunday, July 14, a contractor will have a milling and paving operation on Wilroy Road between Nansemond Parkway and the 2300 block overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. The paving operation is expected to be complete Friday, July 19.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contactor will have Foxcroft Road closed with a detour between Bennetts Pasture Road and Brittany Lane for storm water pipe maintenance from 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily and is expected to be complete by July 24.

(Colonial Avenue) – A contractor will have Colonial Avenue closed with a detour between Northbrook Avenue and Grove Avenue for road realignment. This work is expected to be complete August 2019.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour for approximately 6 months. Variable message boards were placed May 28 to notify motorists of the upcoming closure.

(Magnolia Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be performing drainage upgrades on Magnolia Drive between Brookwood Drive and Camellia Avenue. Full replacement of the curb and gutter will take place during the hours of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. beginning June 3, 2019 with an expected completion date of July 19, 2019. During this time, street parking within the work area will not be permitted and access to driveways may be impacted for a short duration. Residents received notice of the upcoming work on May 24, 2019.
