SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE – ART COURT

SUFFOLK, Virginia (July 29, 2019) Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the scene of a residential structure fire this afternoon, Monday, July 29, 2019, in the 1500 block of Art Court. Emergency Communications was contacted at 2:43 p.m.

Battalion Chief Jack Knight advised that the first units arrived on the scene at 2:50 p.m. and found heavy smoke and fire showing from a residential detached garage. The incident did have a minor extension into two homes but no one will be displaced as a result of the fire. The fire was marked under control at 3:11 p.m. No injuries were reported.

Responding units included Battalion 1, Car 1, Car 4, Engine 1, Engine 2, Engine 3, Fire Marshal 5, Ladder 3, Medic 1A, Rescue 1, Rehab 6, and Safety 1.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.
