**SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE –
RIVER CREEK CRESCENT**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (September 2, 2019) Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the scene of a residential structure fire this afternoon, Monday, September 2, 2019, in the 1500 block of River Creek Crescent. Emergency Communications was contacted at 2:32 p.m.

Battalion Chief Demitri Wilson advised that the first units arrived on the scene at 2:40 p.m. and found a fire in the attached 2 car garage. The fire was contained to the garage with minor smoke throughout the home. One adult was home at the time of the fire and evacuated safely. No injuries were reported. The family was not displaced as a result of the fire.

Responding units included Battalion 1, Engine 3, Ladder 3, Medic 3, Engine 6, Rescue 1, Engine 1, EMS 1 and Safety 1. The fire is under investigation by the Suffolk Fire Marshal's office.
