WOMAN ARRESTED AFTER CHILD FALLS FROM SECOND STORY WINDOW

SUFFOLK, VA (May 29, 2019) Suffolk Police advise that a woman has been arrested following an incident that occurred yesterday afternoon, Wednesday, October 16, 2019, when a 6-year old child fell from a second story window.

Emergency Communications was contacted at 1:28 p.m. advising that the male was injured after falling from the second floor window at the residence in the 200 block of Grace Street. The child received emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel and was ground transported to CHKD Norfolk with serious injuries.

Upon preliminary investigation, Yvonne Wakita Williams, age 24, of Suffolk, was arrested on charges including Abuse And Neglect of Children Endangering Health, and Cruelty and Injuries to Children. She is currently being held at Western Tidewater Regional Jail.

Child Protective Services also responded and the investigation remains ongoing at this time.
