### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (November 8, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, November 8, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Townpoint Road and Shoulders Hill Road 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Pitchkettle Road and Kings Fork Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pitchkettle Road at Kings Fork Road from 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have an eastbound right lane closure on Holland Road between Forest Glen Drive and English Oak Drive from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have an eastbound mobile right lane closure on Pruden Boulevard between Old Myrtle Road and Kings Fork Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 5000 block of Pruden Boulevard from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour for drainage upgrades from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Carolina Road at Old Somerton Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m.

(Kings Fork Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation Kings Fork Road between Pruden Boulevard and Providence Road for vegetation maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 between the 13/32 Bypass and the Chesapeake City Line for large debris removal from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Portsmouth Boulevard for large debris removal from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**Upcoming Projects:**

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Townpoint Road and Shoulders Hill Road 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Monday, November 11, 2019.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway near Golden Maple Drive from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Wednesday, November 13, 2019.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning, Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have alternating southbound lane closures on Bridge Road between Eclipse Drive and the Godwin Bridge for milling and paving overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., November 3 through November 15.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – Beginning, Sunday, October 27, a contractor will have alternating lane closures on Harbour View Boulevard between Bridge Road and Hampton Roads Parkway overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. The milling and paving operation is expected to be completed in 10 days, weather permitting. Message boards were placed on Monday, October 21 to notify motorists.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately December 2019.
