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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 21, 2019) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, November 21, 2019, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Pruden Boulevard/Route 460) – A contractor will have both westbound travel lanes in the 5000 block of Pruden Boulevard/Route 460 at Old Myrtle Road closed. Traffic will be transitioned to the eastbound lanes, restricting traffic to one lane in each direction for approximately 4 to 6 weeks. Message boards have been placed to notify motorists of the change in traffic pattern. Additionally, the speed limit within the work zone area will be lowered to 45 miles per hour beginning on Thursday, November 21st until the end of the project.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 200 block of North Capital Street closed with a detour from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holland Area) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be pothole patching on secondary roads in the Holland area from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Everets Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 6600 - 6700 block of Everets Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will be working within the westbound lane closure on Pruden Boulevard near Old Myrtle Road overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(Culloden Street) – Virginia Dominion Power will have a flagging operation in the 400 block of Culloden Street from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have turn lane closures on Bridge Road between College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Bridge Road between the Godwin Bridge and Eclipse Drive from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have lane closures on Harbour View Boulevard between Bridge Road and Hampton Roads Parkway from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Taylor Road from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

(Hollywood Neighborhood) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be performing drainage maintenance in the Hollywood neighborhood from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Foxcroft Road) – A contractor will have crews working on Foxcroft Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have an eastbound lane closure in the 3000 block of Pruden Boulevard from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 2800 block of Carolina Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 2900 block of Carolina Road for slope mowing from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound mobile operation on Route 58 between Route 272 and the Route 13/32 Interchange for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road/Bennetts Pasture Road/Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road, Bennetts Pasture Road and Nansemond Parkway for asphalt patching from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 3700 block of Nansemond Parkway from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 23 and November 24.

Ongoing Projects:

(Route 58) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures eastbound on Route 58 between the Southampton County line and Holy Neck Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 12 through November 22. Work will be daily including weekends.

(Respass Beach Road) – A contractor will have a northbound lane closure on Respass Beach Road between Hampton Roads Parkway and the 6700 block for curb work from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 19 through November 22.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have an eastbound shoulder closure on Holland Road between Forest Glen Drive and Cove Point Drive from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., November 19 through November 22.

(Turlington Road and Jackson Road) – A contractor will have shoulder closures at the intersection on both Turlington Road and Jackson Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 12 through November 26.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning, Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately May 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Beginning, Thursday, June 27, Mineral Spring Road will be closed between Holland Corner Road and Arthur Drive. The current bridge over Jones Swamp will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The work will also include elevating a section of Mineral Spring Road. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately December 2019.

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
