POLICE INVESTIGATING BREAKING & ENTERING AT LOCAL CAR DEALERSHIP

SUFFOLK, VA (March 11, 2020) Suffolk Police are currently investigating a breaking and entering incident that occurred sometime overnight on Monday, March 9, 2020, or during the early morning hours on Tuesday, March 10, 2020, at Dennis' Auto Sales in the 2900 block of Bridge Road.

Upon preliminary investigation it was determined that the unknown subjects broke a window at the dealership and then stole several vehicle's keys from the business and used them to steal a total of five vehicles from the lot. Two of the stolen vehicles were recovered by Suffolk Officers a short distance from the dealership.

Stolen vehicles still missing include a 2010 Nissan four door sedan, silver in color, a 2008 BMW four door sedan, gold in color, and a 2007 Lexus four door sedan, silver in color.

The investigation remains ongoing at this time.
