UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (March 22, 2020) Suffolk Police advise that the subject in last evening's Officer-involved shooting has been identified as Marvin Antoine Boone, age 35, of Suffolk.

Boone was arrested upon his release from a local hospital on the following charges: Domestic Assault & Battery, Abduction, Use of a Firearm in Commission of Felony, Possession of Firearm by Convicted Felon (2 counts), Disarming a Law Enforcement Officer, Attempted Malicious Wounding of a Law Enforcement Officer, and Obstruction of Justice/Resisting Arrest. He is currently being held without bond at the Western Tidewater Regional Jail.

Suffolk Police would also like to extend their gratitude to the concerned citizens that have reached out to provide assistance, and ask that if anyone may have witnessed these incidents or that has information, please contact Suffolk Police or Suffolk Crime Line. The Internal Affairs Investigation and separate Criminal Investigation remain ongoing at this time.

POLICE INVESTIGATING OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING

SUFFOLK, VA (March 21, 2020) Suffolk Police are investigating an Officer-involved shooting.

Emergency Communications was initially contacted at 7:53 p.m. advising of an armed domestic abduction of an adult female. Upon receiving information regarding the vehicle the female owned, an Officer located the victim's unoccupied vehicle in a shopping center parking lot in the 500 block of East Constance Road and remained on scene. Shortly thereafter, a vehicle with the subject and victim arrived on scene.

The Officer had contact with the subject and a physical altercation ensued, during which time the subject was able to disarm the Officer from his taser. The subject then discharged the taser at the Officer, striking him several times. The Officer returned fire with his service weapon, striking the subject. The Officer provided first aid until the arrival of Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel, who then provided emergency medical assessment and treatment and ground transported the adult male to a local hospital with serious injuries.

An Internal Affairs Investigation and separate Criminal Investigation are currently underway. The Officer has been placed on administrative leave with pay pending the outcome of both investigations.
