ARREST MADE FOLLOWING LATE NIGHT STABBING

SUFFOLK, Virginia (May 5, 2020) - Suffolk Police have arrested an individual following their investigation into an aggravated assault that occurred late last evening, Monday, May 4, 2020, at a residence in the 6000 block of Bradford Drive.

Emergency dispatchers received the call at 11:32 p.m. advising of an adult male that was assaulted by an acquaintance. The victim, identified as Maurice Weaver, age 48, of Suffolk, received emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel for multiple stab wounds and was ground transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Following their investigation, Paul Vincent Bolton, Jr., age 56, of Portsmouth, was arrested and charged with Felonious Assault and Assault & Battery, Simple. Bolton is currently being held at the Western Tidewater Regional Jail. Mug shot attached.
