ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 15, 2020) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, May 15, 2020, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58/Holland Road) – A contractor will have crews working beyond the shoulder on Route 58/Holland Road between Manning Road and the Route 13/32 Bypass from 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., May 13 through May 15.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway between the 3300 block and Portsmouth Boulevard for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Hosier Road and North Liberty Spring Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Hosier Road and North Liberty Spring Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended closed with a detour between North Division Street and North Lloyd Street from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Wellons Street) – A contractor will be working off the road on Wellons Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Turlington Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Services will have a flagging operation on Turlington Road between Dudley Lane and the 600 block from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Carolina Road between Coleman Court and Fayette Street from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Godwin Boulevard between the Route 58 interchange and Kings Highway for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway for vegetation maintenance from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound returning eastbound mobile operation on Route 58 between South Quay Road and the Southampton County line for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(East Washington Street and Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have mobile operations on East Washington Street and Portsmouth Boulevard for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Blythewood Lane) – A contractor will have the 1100 block of Blythewood Lane closed to through traffic for a sewer line installation, May 11 through May 22.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Bright Lane and Withers Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., May 8 through May 15.

(Everets Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6700 block of Everets Road from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., May 12 through May 15.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 3200 block of Pruden Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., April 30 through May 22.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bellflower Lane from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., March 20 through June 12.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 6000 to 6200 blocks of Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 through June 1.

(Old Mill Road) – Beginning Monday, September 23, 2019, Old Mill Road will be closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure. The road is expected to be closed with a detour until approximately June 2020. Variable message boards announcing the closure are in place as of September 16.
