UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (September 25, 2020) Following the investigation, Suffolk Police determined that the incident was unfounded. There is no evidence that an abduction had occurred. As previously noted, the child was found safe at a relative's house.

Child Protective Services was notified of the incident. No further information is available for release.

SUFFOLK POLICE INVESTIGATING ALLEGED CHILD ABDUCTION

SUFFOLK, VA (September 24, 2020) Suffolk Police are currently investigating an alleged child abduction. Emergency Communications was first contacted at 3:19 p.m. advising of an alleged child abduction that occurred in the 400 block of Market Street.

Officers immediately began canvassing the area and searching for the 3-year-old female.

The child was safely located and is currently with family members. The investigation remains ongoing at this time and there is no further information to provide.
