SUFFOLK, VA (December 7, 2020) Suffolk Police advise that the driver of the vehicle was still hospitalized as of Sunday evening. The driver was the single occupant of the vehicle involved in the accident.

The incident remains under investigation. No additional information is available for release.

SUFFOLK POLICE AND SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO TRAIN VS VEHICLE ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (December 7, 2020) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue are on the scene of a train versus a vehicle accident which occurred this evening, Saturday, December 5, 2020 at the intersection of North Capital Street and Railroad Avenue. Emergency Communications was notified of the incident at 10:29 p.m.

The adult female driver of the vehicle is being transported via Nightingale to an area hospital with serious injuries following assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel after being extricated from the vehicle.

The roadway at the immediate location will be closed for an undetermined amount of time.

The accident remains under investigation. No additional information is available for release at this time.
