WOMAN ARRESTED ON THREE CHARGES OF COMMERCIAL ARMED ROBBERY

SUFFOLK, VA (April 6, 2021) Suffolk Police advise that they have arrested a woman following the investigations of three recent Commercial Armed Robberies.

On April 6, 2021, Andrea Bryant, age 29, of Suffolk, was arrested on an outstanding warrant for Contempt of Court. Ms. Bryant has also been identified as the offender from three recent Commercial Armed Robberies, the latest occurring on Tuesday, April 6, 2021, at approximately 1:00 a.m. at the CVS located in the 2700 block of Godwin Boulevard. During this incident, she implied she had a weapon and robbed the store of an unknown amount of cash and products, and then left on foot. No one was injured during this incident.

The other incidents, for which Media Releases and surveillance video photos were previously provided, included the robbery of the Miller Mart in the 2800 block of Pruden Boulevard during the early morning hours on March 29, 2021, and the robbery of the 7-Eleven in the 2100 block of North Main Street during the early morning hours on April 1, 2021. The same methods as noted above were utilized in both of these incidents.

Ms. Bryant was arrested on charges including Robbery (3 counts), and Use of a Firearm in Commission of a Felony (3 counts). Additional charges are forthcoming.

She is currently being held without bond in the Western Tidewater Regional Jail. Mug shot attached.
