POLICE INVESTIGATING RESIDENTIAL BREAKING AND ENTERING

SUFFOLK, VA (May 9, 2021) – Suffolk Police are investigating a residential breaking and entering which occurred earlier this morning, Sunday, May 9, 2021.

Emergency Communications was contacted at 12:54 a.m. advising of the incident in the 200 block of Magnolia Street in the Magnolia Gardens neighborhood.

Upon preliminary investigation, it was determined that two subjects were home when they heard glass break. The offenders, described as a Black male and a White male, entered the residence and displayed a large, military-style rifle. The offenders fled the residence with the victim's purse containing cash and other items. There were no injuries.
