### TEEN INJURED IN OVERNIGHT SHOOTING

SUFFOLK, VA (June 8, 2021) Suffolk Police are currently investigating a shooting incident that occurred last evening, Monday, June 7, 2021, in the 200 block of North 5<sup>th</sup> Street.

Emergency Communications was contacted at 10:06 p.m. advising of shots fired in the West Jericho neighborhood.

Upon preliminary investigation, Officers found a 17-year-old male suffering from a gunshot wound. He received emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel and was ground transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The investigation remains ongoing at this time, and there is no further information available for release.
