SUFFOLK POLICE INVESTIGATING A SHOOTING INTO OCCUPIED DWELLING INCIDENT – FREENEY AVENUE

SUFFOLK, VA (February 18, 2022) Suffolk Police are investigating a shooting into an occupied dwelling incident which occurred last night, Thursday, February 17, 2022, in the 2000 block of Freney Avenue. Emergency Communications was notified of the incident at 9:40 p.m.

Officers arrived on the scene and made contact with the two adult victims who were home at the time of the incident. No injuries were reported.

The investigation remains ongoing at this time, and there is no further information available for release.
