SUFFOLK POLICE ARREST SUBJECT FOR MAKING A SOCIAL MEDIA POST OF AN ACT OF VIOLENCE TO A SCHOOL

SUFFOLK, VA (May 28, 2022) Start of release: at approximately 1302PM, the Suffolk Police Department was notified of a threatening post on a social media platform regarding an act of violence against a school. Detectives investigated the post on the social media threat and found the offender to be Cameron Sears, age 23, a Suffolk resident. Mr. Sears was arrested and charged with threats of death or injury to persons on school property this date and transported to Western Tidewater Regional Jail.

The investigation remains ongoing at this time, and there is no further information available for release.
