## **UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, VA (August 6, 2016) Suffolk Police advise that the roadway has reopened in both directions.

The cause of the accident remains under investigation.

### **MULTI-VEHICLE ACCIDENT ON ROUTE 460**

SUFFOLK, VA (August 6, 2016) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel are currently on the scene of a multi-vehicle accident in the 4800 block of Pruden Boulevard/Route 460 at the intersection of Old Myrtle Road. Emergency Communications received the call at 5:28 p.m. notifying of the incident.

The accident involved a total of five passenger vehicles, and two of the vehicles rolled over.

The occupants of all of the vehicles received emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel and four adults were ground transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The roadway in the area was completely shut down immediately following the accident, with traffic now being alternated eastbound and westbound.

The cause of the accident remains under investigation.
