DUI DRIVER STRIKES VEHICLES AND BUSINESS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 17, 2016) Suffolk Police responded earlier this morning to a single vehicle crash that also damaged several vehicles and a business. Emergency Communications was notified of the accident at approximately 4:46 a.m. in the 2200 block of North Main Street in the parking lot of Mike Duman's Rental/Collision Center.

Upon preliminary investigation it was found that the vehicle, a Lexus SUV, traveled across the median and ran off the roadway, striking the vehicles and the front door of the business, which also sustained minor damage.

The driver of the vehicle was the only occupant. Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel responded and he was treated for non-life threatening injuries and transported to a local hospital, where he was further treated and released.

Keaton Beery, age 23, of Chesapeake was charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and issued summonses for No Valid Operator's License and Failure to Maintain Control.
