POLICE INVESTIGATING AUTO-PEDESTRIAN CRASH

SUFFOLK, Virginia (March 6, 2016) – The Suffolk Police Department is investigating an auto-pedestrian crash which occurred this afternoon in the area of College Drive and University Boulevard in northern Suffolk.

Emergency Communications was made aware of the accident at 1:36 p.m. The driver of the involved vehicle, a Nissan SUV, remained on the scene. Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded and the victim, a 15-year-old male, received emergency medical assessment and treatment and was ground transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

The preliminary investigation revealed that the teen walked into the roadway. The accident remains under investigation.
