UPDATE

SUFFOLK, Virginia (March 23, 2015) Suffolk Police advise that following their investigation into the accident involving a Suffolk Public School bus that occurred yesterday afternoon the driver of the Toyota pick-up, Davin Kavone Bass, age 19, of Suffolk was issued a summons for Reckless Driving.

All 6 of the students as well as the bus driver that were ground transported by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel were treated and released from Sentara Obici Hospital yesterday afternoon.

NANSEMOND PARKWAY ACCIDENT INVOLVING SCHOOL BUS

SUFFOLK, Virginia (March 23, 2015) Suffolk Police are currently investigating a two vehicle accident involving a Suffolk Public School bus and a Toyota pick-up truck that occurred in the 1700 block of Nansemond Parkway this afternoon.

Emergency Communications was advised of the accident that occurred at 4:20 p.m. involving a bus transporting students from Nansemond Parkway Elementary School.

All of the occupants received emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel. A total of 6 students as well as the bus driver

were ground transported to Sentara Obici Hospital for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

The roadway was closed for approximately 45 minutes immediately following the accident while students were transported and the vehicles were removed from the roadway.

The investigation is ongoing.
