HEAD-ON COLLISION CLOSSES MILLS E. GODWIN BRIDGE

SUFFOLK, Virginia (July 11, 2015) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue crews are currently on the scene of a head-on collision that occurred in the 2200 block of Bridge Road on the Mills E. Godwin Bridge

Emergency Communications received the call at 4:25 a.m. advising of the accident involving a Toyota Camry and Dodge Charger. The vehicles were only occupied by the drivers, and both males had to be extricated from their vehicles.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue crews were assisted by the Chuckatuck Volunteer Fire Department during the extrications. The drivers received medical assessment and treatment and were ground transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with serious but non-life threatening injuries.

The Mills E. Godwin Bridge is expected to remain closed until approximately 6:15 a.m. as the vehicles and debris are removed from the roadway.

The cause of the accident remains under investigation.
