SUFFOLK POLICE SEEKING PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IN IDENTIFYING CREDIT CARD FRAUD SUSPECTS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 6, 2016) The Suffolk Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in identifying two suspects each believed to be involved in separate credit card theft and fraud incidents. Both of the suspects are also believed to be involved in the theft of a vehicle and thefts from a vehicle incidents in the City of Suffolk.

The one suspect, pictured wearing a dark colored baseball cap, camouflage jacket, dark colored jeans, and black shoes, was reportedly involved in credit card theft and fraud that occurred in the City of Suffolk on April 19, 2016.

The other suspect, a black male wearing a dark colored jacket, was reportedly involved in credit card theft and fraud that occurred in the City of Suffolk on April 20, 2016. This suspect is believed to reside in the City of Norfolk.

The two credit card theft and fraud incidents are not believed to be related.
