### **SUFFOLK POLICE SEEKING PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IN IDENTIFYING CHECK FRAUD SUSPECTS**

SUFFOLK, VA (July 31, 2015) The Suffolk Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in identifying two male suspects involved in check fraud committed at the Navy Federal Credit Union located in Portsmouth and Virginia Beach, in addition to the Wells Fargo in Portsmouth during the week of June 22<sup>nd</sup> through June 26, 2015. The victim resides in Suffolk and the victim's checks were stolen on a prior event.

Video surveillance captured images of the suspects at these locations.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up<sup>SM</sup>. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. Citizens can also utilize TipSoft to anonymously submit crime-related tips through the Web, a text message, or from any Android or iPhone mobile device with the TipSubmit mobile app. Tips can be submitted by visiting [www.suffolkva.us/crimelinetips](http://www.suffolkva.us/crimelinetips), or by texting the word "CRIMES" (274637) with the keyword SPDVATIP. TipSoft also supports users' ability to submit videos or photos using the TipSoft mobile app. If

information leads to an arrest, the caller or “tipster” could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
