### SUFFOLK POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IN CREDIT CARD FRAUD INCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (February 25, 2015) Suffolk Police are seeking the public's assistance in identifying two female suspects involved in a credit card fraud incident where the victim's credit card was used at several stores in Greenbrier Mall in Chesapeake, Virginia, and in several stores in Lynnhaven Mall in Virginia Beach, Virginia on January 29, 2015. The suspects also used another victim's credit card at a Total Wine store on another occasion.

Video surveillance captured images of the suspects at multiple locations.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-LOCK-U-UP<sup>SM</sup>. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. Citizens can also utilize TipSoft to anonymously submit crime-related tips through the Web, a text message, or from any Android or iPhone mobile device with the TipSubmit mobile app. Tips can be submitted by visiting [www.suffolkva.us/crimelinetips](http://www.suffolkva.us/crimelinetips), or by texting the word "**CRIMES**" (274637) with the keyword **SPDVATIP**. TipSoft also supports users' ability to submit videos or photos using the TipSoft mobile app. If information leads to an arrest, the caller or "tipster" could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
