TWO VEHICLE ACCIDENT BOUNDARY DRIVE

SUFFOLK, Virginia (January 12, 2015) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel responded earlier this afternoon to a two vehicle accident with entrapment.

Emergency Communications received the call at 3:29 p.m. advising of the head-on collision off Kings Fork Road in the 1000 block of Boundary Drive involving a Saturn and a Toyota Scion.

One of the drivers, an 18-year-old female, had to be removed from her vehicle by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel using heavy duty equipment. She received emergency medical treatment and assessment and was ground transported to Sentara Norfolk General with non-life threatening injuries. The driver and passenger in the other involved vehicle also received emergency medical treatment and assessment before being ground transported to Sentara Obici Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The roadway was briefly closed as crews worked to remove the vehicles and debris.

The at-fault driver was issued a summons for Failure to Obey Highway Markings.
