UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (July 26, 2014) The victim in this afternoon's accident died this evening in the hospital as a result of the injuries he suffered in the head on collision. He has been identified as Danny Clay Tackett, age 60, of Seaford, Virginia. The cause of the accident remains under investigation.

HEAD ON COLLISION INJURES ONE

SUFFOLK, VA (July 26, 2014) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded earlier this afternoon to a head on collision in the 5500 block of Godwin Boulevard at the intersection of Everets Road.

The accident occurred at 1:48 p.m. and involved a motorcycle and a GMC pick-up. The driver of the truck was not injured but the motorcyclist received life-threatening injuries and was airlifted to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital for treatment.

The motorcyclist, a 60-year-old male, was riding with a group of other motorcyclists when the accident occurred. The cause of the accident remains under investigation. Both directions of Godwin Boulevard were closed for approximately 45 minutes following the accident.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue was also assisted by the Chuckatuck Volunteer Fire Department.
