POLICE SEEK TO IDENTIFY SUSPECTS IN USE OF STOLEN CREDIT CARD

SUFFOLK, VA (November 18, 2014) Suffolk Police are seeking the public's assistance in identifying two suspects involved in the use of a credit card which was stolen from Suffolk and used at the Lowe's Store in the 4000 block of Victory Boulevard in Portsmouth.

The female subject reportedly took a purse from an elderly customer's cart at the Walmart located in the 1200 block of North Main Street in Suffolk, Virginia on July 28, 2014. The purse contained a credit card belonging to the victim which was used on the same day within hours of the theft. Video surveillance captured images of the suspects and the Suffolk Police hope those images will be helpful in identifying them.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. Citizens can also utilize TipSoft to anonymously submit crime-related tips through the Web, a text message, or from any Android or iPhone mobile device with the [TipSubmit mobile app](#). ability to submit videos or photos using the TipSoft mobile app. If information leads to an arrest, the caller or “tipster” could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
