### **SUFFOLK POLICE SEEK SHOPLIFTING SUSPECTS**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (April 25, 2014) Suffolk Police are seeking the public's assistance in identifying three suspects reportedly involved in a shoplifting incident at the Kohl's Department Store, 6200 block of College Drive, on April 18, 2014 at approximately 6:54 p.m.

The first suspect is described as a black female, 5'4", 150 to 160 pounds, wearing a jean jacket with two hooded sweatshirts and carrying a black rectangular purse. The second suspect is described as a black female, 5'2" to 5'3", approximately 180 pounds, large build, wearing a brown hooded sweatshirt, and carrying a black shoulder bag. The third suspect is described as a black female, 5'6" to 5'7", 135 pounds, wearing a jean jacket, white zipped up sweatshirt, and with her hair pulled up into a bun. The suspects are involved in the shoplifting of \$272 of store merchandise.

Surveillance cameras captured images of the suspects while in the store.
