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## **UPDATE**

(Route 58) -- A contractor will have an eastbound lane closure at the scales on Route 58 overnight from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (December 14, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, December 14, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have the outside lanes north and southbound closed on North Main Street between VDOT and Murphys Mill Road. This closure will be in place 24 hours per day, December 14<sup>th</sup> through December 17<sup>th</sup>.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound lane closure in the 2600 block of Bridge Road for utility work from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. This work zone will be intermittent for the next 6 months.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Whaleyville Boulevard from the North Carolina state line to Carolina Road for drainage and ditch maintenance from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pughsville Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a lane closure in the 4100 block of Pughsville Road for utility work from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile lane closures on Bridge Road between Bennetts Pasture Road and Eclipse Drive from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right turn lane closed at the truck stop westbound in the 2800 block of Pruden Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound lane closure at the scales on Route 58 overnight from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., December 13<sup>th</sup> through December 15<sup>th</sup>.

(East Washington Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on East Washington Street at the train trestle for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Gates Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 8800 block of Gates Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

## **Ongoing Projects:**

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be demolishing and reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists. This closure will remain until the estimated completion date of January 31, 2017.

(Godwin Boulevard on ramp from Route 58 WB) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on ramp from Route 58 westbound daily.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a January 2017 completion date.

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
