POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVES

SUFFOLK, VA (June 9, 2015) Two super load moves, both involving the hauling of a mobile home, could cause delays in traffic Wednesday, June 10, 2015, at 9:45 a.m. for the first unit and 1 p.m. for the second unit.

The trucks will begin their journeys in North Carolina and travel through Suffolk on northbound Route 32 to northbound Route 13 to the Route 13/32 Bypass to westbound Route 13/58/460 Suffolk Bypass to the 1200 block of Lummis Road.

The trucks and loads will each measure 15 feet tall, 16 feet wide, 80 feet long, and weigh 54,000 pounds.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts as well as Suffolk Police escorts.
