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## **UPDATE**

(Kings Highway) -- The 300 block of Kings Highway will be closed for approximately 4 hours while a contractor responds to a leaning telephone pole. A detour is in place.

### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (March 1, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, March 1, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Wellons Street) – The 300 block of Wellons Street remains closed due to cleanup efforts for a train derailment.

(Hillpoint Boulevard) – A contractor will have an inside lane and median closure westbound on Hillpoint Boulevard between Gunston Drive and Hillpoint Woods. This closure will be in place until 4 p.m., Friday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>.

(Arthur Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Arthur Drive for pothole patching from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Old Myrtle Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 6800 block of Old Myrtle Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 189) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 189 for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 for debris pick up from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Farrand Drive) – A contractor will have Farrand Drive closed between Hillpoint Boulevard and Jacyln Drive.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(College Drive) – A contractor will have an outside lane closure northbound on College Drive between the entrance to Jersey Mike’s Subs and Lake View Parkway near the I-664 exit and the right turn lane onto Lake View Parkway. The contractor will also have the left turn lane onto northbound College Drive on Hampton Roads Parkway closed from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily until March 7<sup>th</sup>.

(Grove Avenue and Delaney Drive) – A contractor will be installing the HRSD force main on Grove Avenue and Delaney Drive requiring occasional detours and lane closures. Work is scheduled to begin December 19<sup>th</sup> and estimated to be complete in March 2017. Work hours will be 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

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
