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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (March 27, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, March 27, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(James Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have James Avenue closed between Respass Beach Road and Hoffler Street Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for storm drain installations. Work is expected to be complete by April 31st, weather dependent.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will be working southbound in the 800 block of Carolina Road daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. This work will periodically require a southbound left shoulder or lane closure.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have a northbound right lane closure in the 6800 block of Harbour View Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a northbound right lane closure in the 1900 block of North Main Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Murphys Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 900 block of Murphys Mill Road at the bridge from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Repass Beach Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Repass Beach Road between Hampton Roads Parkway and Bay Circle from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a right lane closure in the 300 block of Carolina Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 between Kenyon Road and the Southampton County line for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Commerce Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane closure on Commerce Street at East Washington Street for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Hillpoint Boulevard) – A contractor will have the inside lane and median closed westbound on Hillpoint Boulevard between Gunston Drive and Hillpoint Woods from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(East Washington Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 100 block of East Washington Street to perform a manhole rehabilitation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., March 28th.

Ongoing Projects:

(Various Locations) – A contractor will be working within the City of Suffolk for approximately 3 weeks, weather dependent, from March 20th through April 10th. The contractor will perform pavement condition assessments of the City's roadway network. The operation will not interfere with traffic or pedestrians.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have an outside lane closure northbound on College Drive between the entrance to Jersey Mike's Subs and Lake View Parkway near the I-664 exit and the right turn lane onto Lake View Parkway. The contractor will also have the left turn lane onto northbound College Drive on Hampton Roads Parkway closed from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily until March 31st.

(Grove Avenue and Delaney Drive) – A contractor will be installing the HRSD force main on Grove Avenue and Delaney Drive requiring occasional detours and lane closures. Work is scheduled to begin December 19th and estimated to be complete in March 2017. Work hours will be 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

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
