ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 15, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, May 15, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 between the Southampton County line and the Route 13/32 Bypass for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(West Riverview Drive) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 500 block of West Riverview Drive from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a right turn lane closure eastbound in the 3100 block of Godwin Boulevard at Farmall Drive from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Great Fork Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Great Fork Road between Little Fork Road and the North Carolina State line for side cutting from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound in the inside lane on Route 58 from the Pitchkettle Road exit to the 6 lanes continuing westbound in the inside lane from the Chesapeake City line to the Route 13/32 Bypass from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 460) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Route 460 between North Main Street and the Isle of Wight line for vegetation maintenance from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will be working northbound in the 800 block of Carolina Road daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. This work will periodically require a northbound left shoulder or lane closure.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.
