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UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (November 30, 2012) The contractor working for Hampton Roads Sanitation District completed the resurfacing of Wilroy Road which reopened this evening to traffic.

UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (November 26, 2012) The Hampton Roads Sanitation District has completed the repairs to their Wilroy Road force main. At this time, road restoration improvements will begin this week with the impacted road area re-surfaced by Wednesday, December 5th. Upon completion of the asphalt re-surfacing, Wilroy Road will be reopened to traffic.

UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (November 1, 2012) Upon completion of an initial assessment of the damage to the sewer main leak off of Wilroy Road, Hampton Roads Sanitation District (HRSD) personnel and their contractor have determined that Wilroy Road will need to remain closed for up to 4 weeks for repairs to be completed.

HRSD assures that all measures will be taken to minimize the extent of the road closure.

**WILROY ROAD TO BE CLOSED DUE TO HRSD SEWER MAIN REPAIR
WORK**

SUFFOLK, VA (October 30, 2012) The 800 block of Wilroy Road will be closed to thru traffic from 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, October 31 until Friday, November 2 while Hampton Roads Sanitation District (HRSD) personnel coordinate an assessment for an emergency repair of a leaking sanitary sewer force main. The HRSD sewer main is located in a marshy area of Shingle Creek located off Wilroy Road.

Local access will be permitted during the work. HRSD and their contractor will have detour signage in place at the Wilroy Road/Suburban Drive and Wilroy Road/Constance Road intersections. Detours will direct travelers to utilize Nansemond Parkway, Progress Road, Suburban Drive, and Route 58.

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
