ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (June 29, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, June 29, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58) – Public Works will have a mobile operation east and westbound on Route 58 at the bridges and overpasses for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway/Shoulders Hill Road) – Public Works will have mobile operations on Nansemond Parkway and Shoulders Hill Road spraying herbicide from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pitchkettle Road) – Public Works will have a flagging operation on Pitchkettle Road between Constance Road and the Route 58 Overpass for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Box Elder Road) – Public Works will have a flagging operation on Box Elder Road between Leesville Road and Quaker Road for asphalt repair from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(South Quay Road) – Dominion Power will have a flagging operation in the 6700 block of South Quay Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a left lane closure eastbound on Route 58 near the scales for guardrail repair from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have mobile operations east and westbound on Route 58 between the Southampton County line and Holland Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Route 58) – Public Works Traffic Engineering's Paint crew will have mobile lane closures eastbound on Route 58 between Pioneer Road and Kenyon Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Kings Fork Road) – Public Works Traffic Engineering's Paint crew will have mobile lane closures on Kings Fork Road between Pruden Boulevard and Kings Point Drive from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Godwin Boulevard) - A contractor will have the westbound right lane closed on Godwin Boulevard between the Route 58 Overpass and Burnetts Way on Friday, June 30th, from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. Suffolk Police Department will be on scene to assist with traffic control.

Ongoing Projects:

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing a water line in the Oak Ridge Neighborhood. Work will require lane closures throughout the neighborhood beginning on Westgate Avenue and is expected to continue through August.

(College Drive) - A contractor will have the northbound right turn lane closed on College Drive at Lakeview Parkway through July 15th for a sidewalk installation daily from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
