**SUFFOLK POLICE ARREST TWO SUBJECTS FOLLOWING  
STABBING**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (July 14, 2017) – Suffolk Police advise that two subjects have been arrested following their investigation into a stabbing incident that occurred Thursday evening, July 13, 2017.

Emergency Communications was contacted at 7:30 p.m. and Suffolk Police responded to a parking lot in the 400 block of Carolina Road where an adult male was located suffering from a stab wound.

The victim received emergency medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel and was ground transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Following their investigation, Fantasia Aimee Lowrance, age 33, of Gates, North Carolina, was arrested on charges of Malicious Wounding and Shoot, Stab, Cut or Wound, and Reshawn Phillips, age 40, of Suffolk, was arrested on a charge of Malicious Wounding. They are both currently being held at Western Tidewater Regional Jail. Mug shots are attached.

The victim has been identified as Nathaniel Jerome Hart, age 35, of Corapeake, North Carolina. The subjects were known to one another.
