POLICE INVESTIGATING BANK ROBBERY

SUFFOLK, VA (October 10, 2017) Suffolk Police are currently investigating a bank robbery which occurred at the BayPort Credit Union located in the 1400 block of North Main Street earlier this morning.

Emergency Communications received a call at 10:20 a.m. advising that a black male entered the bank and handed the teller a note demanding money. The subject fled on foot after receiving an undisclosed amount of currency. There were no injuries.

The subject was further described as approximately 5'8" to 5'9" tall, weighing approximately 180 to 190 pounds, between 45 and 55, with a mustache and partial goatee. He was wearing a dark shirt and pants, dark colored shoes, and black ball cap with a New York Yankees logo.

TipSoft also supports users’ ability to submit videos or photos using the TipSoft mobile app. If information leads to an arrest, the caller or “tipster” could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
