POLICE INVESTIGATING ATTEMPTED COMMERCIAL ROBBERY

SUFFOLK, Virginia (December 29, 2017) Suffolk Police are investigating an attempted commercial robbery that occurred this morning, December 29, 2017, at the Chartway Federal Credit Union located in the 3500 block of Bridge Road. Emergency Communications was made aware of the incident at 10:46 a.m.

Upon preliminary investigation, it was found that a male suspect entered the business and provided a note to the clerk demanding money. The clerk did not give him anything and the suspect took his note back and fled the scene. No one was injured during the incident.

The subject is described as a black male, approximately 50 years of age, wearing a black hoodie, black pants, and a white dust/surgical mask covering his mouth and nose. Police believe this incident may be linked to a robbery that occurred on December 19, 2017 at the Chartway Federal Credit Union located in the 1400 block of North Main Street.
