POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IN IDENTIFYING SUBJECTS IN COUNTERFEIT MONEY INCIDENTS

SUFFOLK, VA (April 24, 2018) Suffolk Police are seeking the public's assistance in identifying three suspects wanted in relation to incidents involving the passing of counterfeit bills at the GameStop store located in the 1200 block of North Main Street.

Police were notified of the incidents which reportedly occurred on February 9, 2018 and March 1, 2018 where counterfeit bills were used in purchases at this location. Included with this release are photographs pulled from surveillance video at the store showing the suspects.
