SUFFOLK POLICE SEEKING PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE TO IDENTIFY CREDIT CARD FRAUD SUSPECT

SUFFOLK, VA (September 28, 2018) Suffolk Police are requesting the public's assistance in identifying a suspect wanted for Credit Card Fraud throughout the City of Suffolk and other areas in Hampton Roads.

The suspect may be connected with other "skimming devices" that have been used throughout the areas as the card he was in possession of and using in Suffolk contained the victim's information to complete several fraudulent transactions.

With this information they can login at p3tips.com and submit follow-up information, engage in two-way dialogue, be informed of the outcome of the tip, and access any pertinent reward information.
