DRIVER AIRLIFTED FOLLOWING SINGLE VEHICLE ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (November 6, 2018) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded earlier this evening to a single vehicle accident in the 3500 block of Carolina Road.

Emergency Communications was contacted at 4:02 p.m. advising of the accident involving a Toyota pick-up truck that left the roadway and struck a tree. The adult male driver, the only occupant, had to be extricated from the vehicle by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel. He received emergency medical assessment and treatment and was airlifted by Nightingale to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The roadway was closed for approximately an hour following the accident.

The cause of the accident is under investigation.
